

Segmented projectile for equipping a cartridge of any caliber intended for small arms has a main striking element and additional striking elements, the first and the last, coaxially and sequentially arranged in the shell. A standard bullet is used as the main striking element, the end of the tail part of which is opposite the first additional striking element. The shell covers all the additional striking elements and the tail part of the standard bullet in such a way as to form an integral structure of a segmented projectile, the guiding part of which is a standard bullet. The head part of the bullet protrudes from the open end of the shell, and its tail part is the closed end of the shell, to which the last of the additional striking elements adjoins inside the shell.
