

Method for anchorage loading and unloading vessels in roadstead off an unequipped shore involves positioning the vessel in the roadstead and using ropes to move cargo. Using a system of pulleys secured on one side to support structures installed on the shore and on the other to the vessel, an endless load-bearing rope is tensioned between the shore and the vessel so that a gap is formed between its strands, sufficient for the cargo platforms suspended from each strand to move freely apart.
