

Method for protecting window openings fitted with glazed frames involves installing vertical retaining elements using box-shaped clamps, which are placed on the exterior side of wall adjacent to window openings. Vertical elements are made in the form of small-diameter tubular shafts, ends of which are equipped with bearings to which cables are attached, and protective flexible curtain is connected to the middle horizontal sections of cables. Manual drive, designed as gear transmission and located on window sills, is connected to the lower bearings of each of these shafts.
