

Method for producing millet groats involves hulling the grain, sorting of hulled products, polishing, sorting of polished products. Millet grains with a moisture content of no more than 14% are steamed in batch steamers at a steam pressure of 0.15-0.20 MPa for 7-10 min, dried in dryers to a moisture content of no more than 14%. The grain processed in this manner is hulled once on single-deck roller hullers, passed twice through air separators, polished once, inspected first on a single set of air separators and then on a photo-separator. The kernels are steamed in steamers at a steam pressure of 0.10-0.15 MPa for 10-15 minutes, dried in dryers to a moisture content of no more than 14%, inspected, and packaged.
