

Method for rapid histological processing of tissues from a biological specimen includes fixation, washing, dehydration, degreasing, impregnation with paraffin solvent, embedding in paraffin, sectioning, deparaffinization, and staining. Fixation is performed over a period of 24-48 hours, while dehydration and degreasing are carried out using isopropyl alcohol at a concentration of 99.9% in an automated process.
